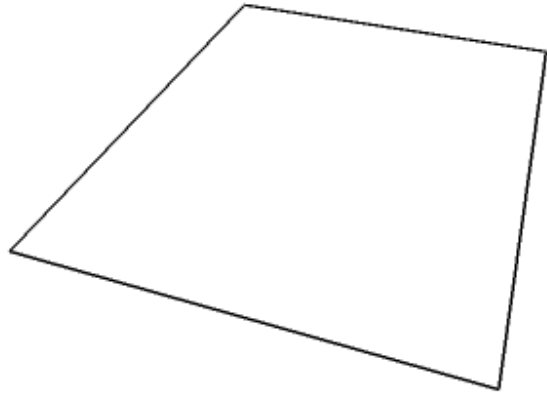
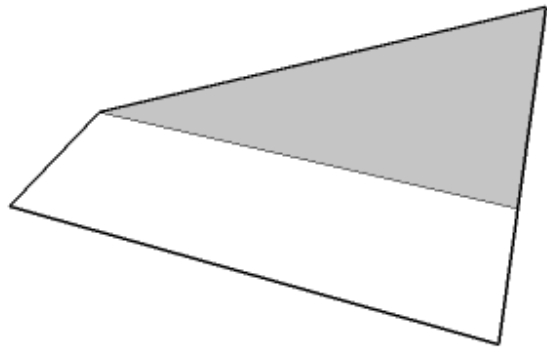


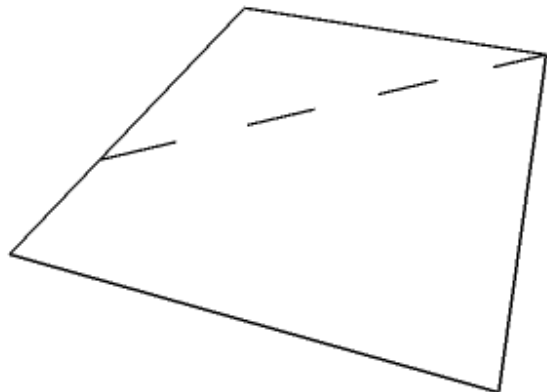
Start with a standard 8.5" x 11" piece of paper.



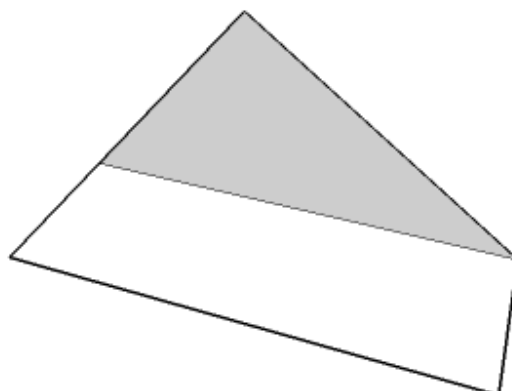
Fold the top-left corner down.



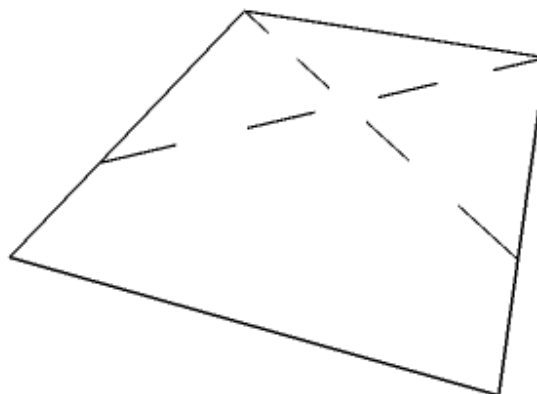
Unfold.



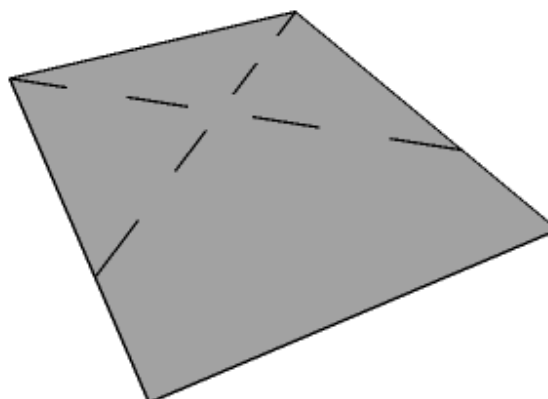
Do the same with the top-right corner.



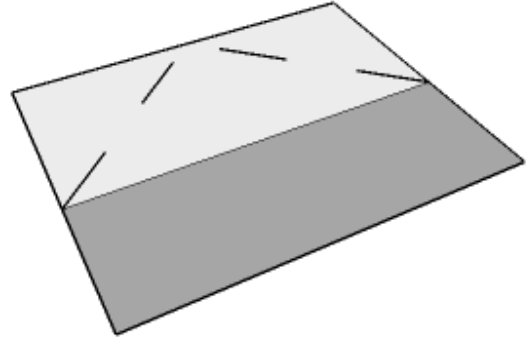
Unfold again.



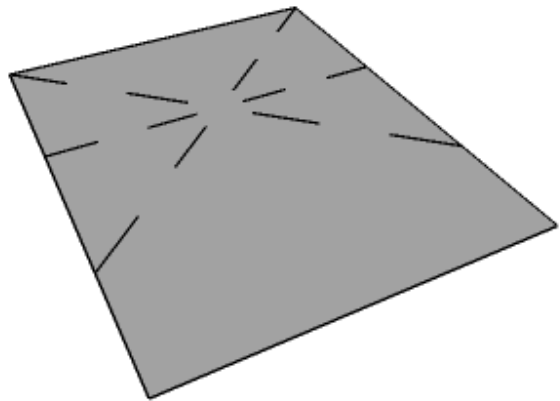
Turn paper over.



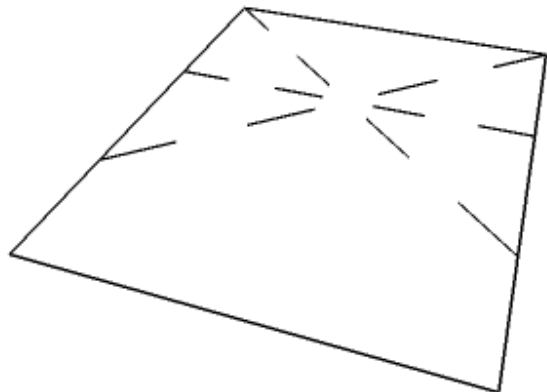
Fold top edge down to the bottom of the diagonal creases.



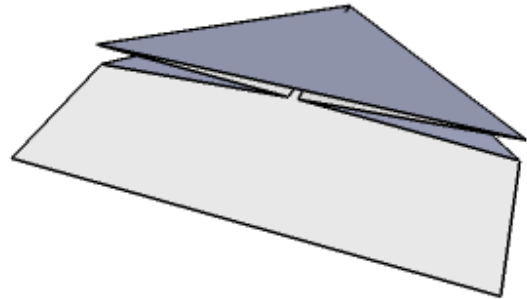
Unfold.



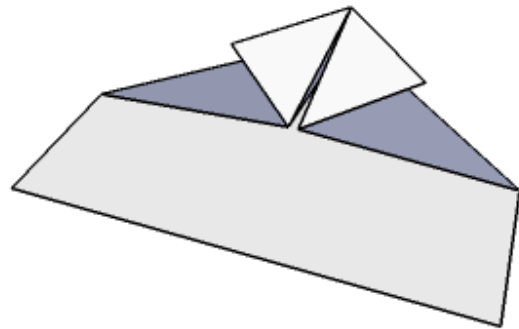
Turn paper over again.



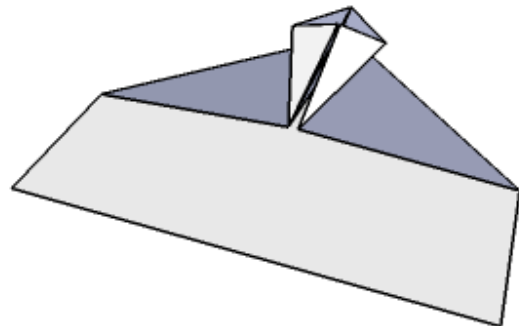
Bring the ends of the horizontal crease together. If you've done everything correctly up to this point, this should move along naturally without any resistance and all the necessary creases will already have been made.



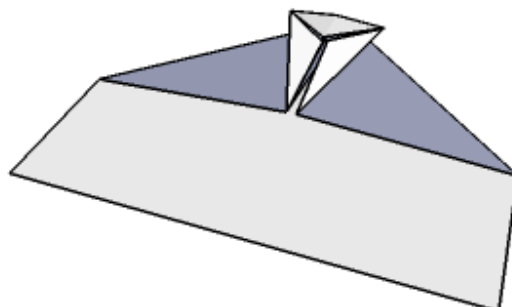
Fold the ends of the newly formed triangle up towards the top.



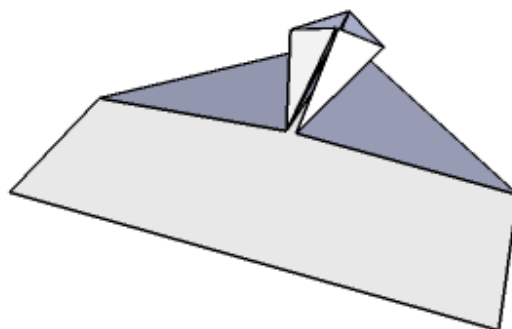
Fold the left and right corners of the diamond towards the middle.



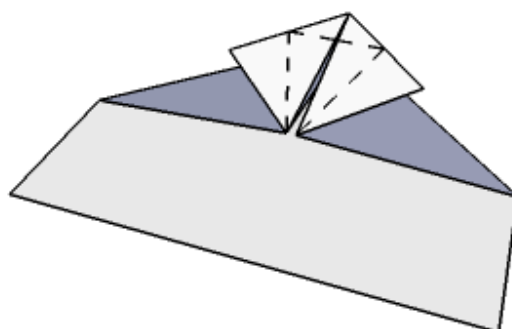
Fold the small triangle at the tip down.



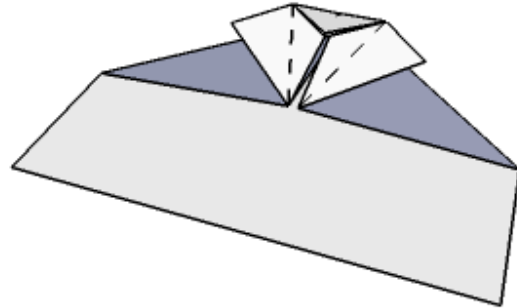
Unfold the small triangle you just folded down.



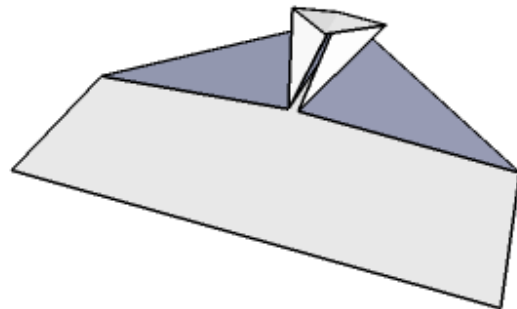
Open up the diamond again.



Fold the small triangle down again.



Notice that the small triangle you just folded down has two layers. The top layer has a slit that you must now slide the diamond sides into. You'll have to bend the diamond a little bit to get both to go in, but it should rest flat inside once in.



Turn the sides up to create winglets. Enjoy!
